Demand Side Management Incentives

The following table represents the maximum amount per Demand Side Management (DSM) incentive that the CEDR Program will contribute. Terms and Conditions and detailed requirements will be provided upon funding approval.

Energy assessments and cost estimate development	\$1,000
<i>Envelope measures</i>	
Attic insulation and draught-proofing	\$5,500
Basement/crawlspace insulation and draft-proofing	\$5,500
Other insulation (e.g., exterior wall sheathing and cavity)	\$5,500
Windows and exterior doors	\$1,400/rough opening, up to \$9,800
Air sealing	\$2,000
Programmable thermostats	\$100/thermostat, up to \$600
<i>Heat pumps</i>	All heat pumps must have an AHRI certified reference number that references all components of the heat pump system and must be on the Home Renovation Rebate and CleanBC Better Homes program heat pump qualified product list.
Central air-source heat pump system	\$16,000
Mini/multi split air-source heat pump system	\$11,000
Electrical service upgrades	\$1,200
Heat pump water heater	\$4,500
Ground-source heat pump	\$12,000

Mould, pest, vermiculite remediation	\$3,000
Ventilation	\$2,000

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
